Dear Parents,

Thank you to the parents who have offered to provide transport for camp. We have allocated students to cars for the journey to and from camp.

We will be leaving school at approximately 9.30am. **For safety reasons we would appreciate if you didn't bring your cars into the school grounds.** As the majority of the children's gear will be loaded onto either a trailer or ute, the children will only need to carry their day pack with them, and these can be walked out to the cars.

Utes and trailers need to be in the school grounds before 8.15am

Last minute reminders:

Ensure your child has packed

- Pillow, sheet and sleeping bag
- Pencil case
- Sunhat
- Raincoat
- Spare sneakers (essential)
- Lunch and drink for Tuesday
- A small day pack (school bag will be ok)
- Book to read
- Medication to Mrs Hagarty on Tuesday morning
- Home baking (slices and biscuits are easier to transport to and from activities)

Students are to bring their gear to the deck outside Room 5 for packing onto the trailer. Own child's gear can remain in parents car.

Upon arrival at camp, we ask that students remain in cars with parents until the teachers arrive.

The children will be given a tour of the camp and fire drill before taking their gear into the dorms.
