Dear Participant / Guardian,

Your School, St Peters Catholic, has engaged with Bigfoot Adventures Limited to provide some of the activities at Camp Bentzon on the 25<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> June 2018. You as parent / guardian are being asked to provide informed consent for your child to take part in some adventurous activities with managed risks. As part of the consent process, it is important that you know the activities your child may participate in and understand the associated risks involved with these activities. Therefore, please consider the below information when completing the Risk Consent Form.

**Activity Information:**

The planned activities being provided by Bigfoot Adventures are:

- Abseiling
- Rock Climbing

When planned activities cannot be implemented due to weather, natural disasters or unforeseen circumstances contingencies may be required. Contingency activities are kept similar or lower risk than the original activities. If any new risk is introduced, appropriate disclosure will be given and consent will be sought from group leader and participant. Your school/group activity leader are involved in the contingency planning process.

With all outdoor activities, there are associated risks. Below is a list of the typical and occasional harms associated with such activities. The level of genuine real risk, as opposed to perceived risk associated with our activities are low - medium.

Typical harms: Cuts & scrapes, bruising, blisters, muscles strains, cold stress, emotional stress, sore fingers, rope burns, sprains, water/height associated fears, enclosed spaces associated fears.

Occasional harms: Serious injury from fall, moderated bruising/pinching, vomiting, severe allergic reaction (food, bees, other), concussion, hypothermia, burns from cooking, dislocations, fractures, fatigue, severe emotional stress.

If your programme is using external caterers that Bigfoot has organised: Risk from cross contamination or an absolute allergy free environment cannot be guaranteed. While our caterers make every practicable effort to ensure all risk is minimised, camp kitchens are not professionally graded and transport of foods across locations expose further risks.
