I am sure you were as pleased as I was to hear the Prime Minister's announcement about moving to Alert Level 1 on Monday. For us, there will be no major changes to what we are doing and our school continues to be safe to attend, including any staff and children who are considered more vulnerable to COVID. We have a good cleaning routine in place, people who are sick are staying at home and we continue to encourage good hygiene practices.

We are supporting contact tracing by having QR code posters at our entrances – so if you haven't already downloaded the NZ COVID Tracer app the Ministry of Health's [NZ-COVID Tracer app page](#) has information to help you do that.

We have found that some of our systems from Level 2 have worked better than anticipated. So therefore we are continuing with the following:

Drop-offs and Pick Ups:

- Drop off - system to continue. Parents will park on the road and will farewell children from their car park. Parents can come in with an appointment signing in on either the school App or via Vistab.
- Pick Up - Continue with the Pick up zone outside the school, and the parking area on the Church side. **Pick up time is back to 3pm**

Sign in:

As part of our Health & Safety Plan, parents or visitors to the school site to meet with a teacher, visit the office, sports practices etc must sign in via either the School App or Vistab in the Office.

We can now look forward to inter-school and community sport, cultural events and performances and to welcoming all of our school community on-site for these activities.
