Nā tō rourou nā taku rourou - ka ora ai te iwi. With your food basket and my food basket the people will thrive

This whakatauki is perfect this week as we are planning our Learning Discussions. For our students to thrive in their learning it is important that we work together, school and home sharing what each knows about the child and their learning. This is reinforced by "Parents and whanau play a critical role in supporting their children's learning right from the start. Evidence shows that learning outcomes are enhanced when parental involvement in school is sustained and focused on learning activites." (Ka Hikitia, p.28) Ka Hikitia is a well respected Ministry of Education New Zealand document.


