Last Friday there was a Teacher Only Day, where all teachers in the COL came together at Cambridge High School for a range of workshops to help improve teacher practice. The inspirational speakers included our Commissioner for Children, Judge Andrew Becroft, growth mindset expert, James Anderson and psychologist Nathan Wallis. These keynote speakers were supported by Waikato Director of Education, Paula Rawiri and the Waikato Tainui Education Team. Our teachers benefitted from the opportunity to reflect on their practice, and network with others in the education world.

The COL also has John Parsons booked for next term, mid August to talk to students about cyber safety. There will also be parent sessions available to attend in the evenings. More information will follow closer to the time.

Installing the St Peters Catholic School App


1. First, visit the store to download the SchoolAppsNZ app...

Trinity Sunday

The Bible says there is "One God and Father of all," but God is made up of three persons – the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. That is what we call the Trinity. Perhaps you have noticed that when someone is baptised the Priest says, "I baptise you in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit." When you hear those words – Father, Son and Holy Spirit — we are talking about the Trinity — one God in three persons.

As simple as that sounds, the Trinity is hard to understand. It is a mystery to us - something we can think about and wonder about. People have used many, many different things to try and help explain what the trinity is. As you probably know, the egg is made up of three parts. The first part is the shell. The next part you see is the egg white. When you cut a boiled egg in half you see the yellow yolk. The egg has three parts — the shell, the white, and the yolk — but only ONE egg. In the same way, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are three persons but only ONE God.

God, we thank you for being all-powerful and all-knowing and for loving us. We thank you for the things in life that we don't completely understand and for giving us the faith to believe them anyway. In the name of Jesus we pray. Amen.


- 1 x portable Basketball/netball hoop on a stand or small soccer goal
